

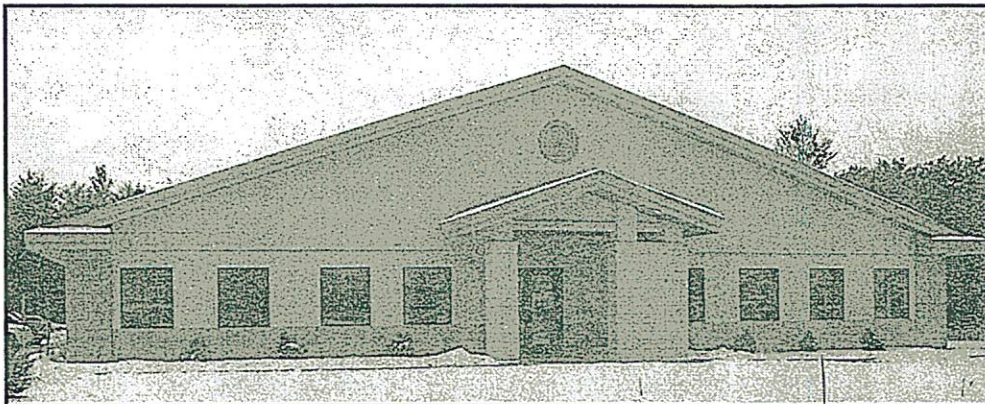

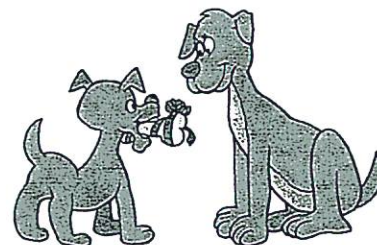

Another great group of employees from Associated Bank in Point held a fun themed basket raffle and donated all the proceeds to our pets who were very happy critters!

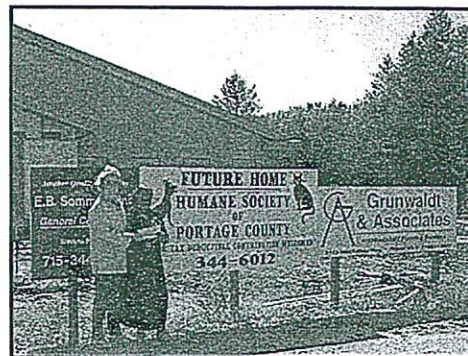
This year Santa was really getting around .

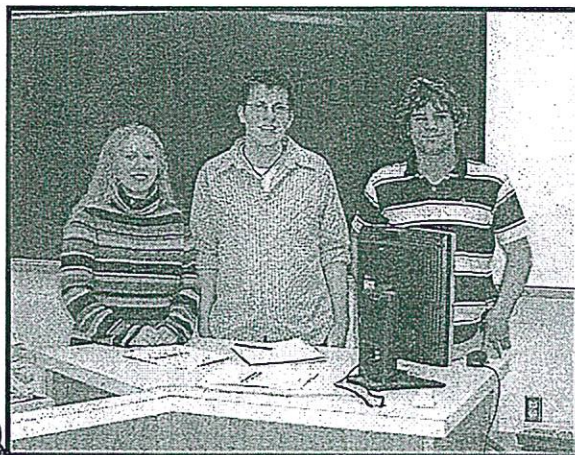
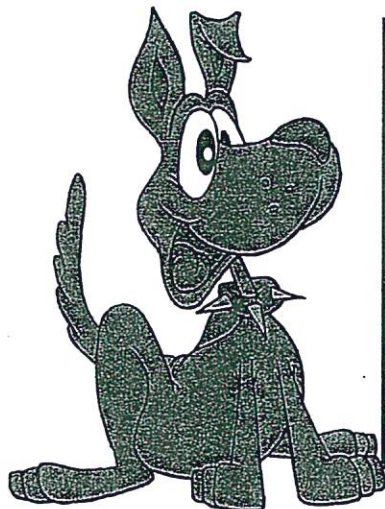
Humane Society Website Redesigned by Students at UWSP
