At the end of last year we had a donation towards a new dental unit as it was harder to find the necessary replacement parts for our older unit. Since the upgrade we were able to discontinue the use of nitrogen tanks because the upgrade to a newer no longer needed the nitrogen supply to function. This upgrade has allowed us to discontinue the purchase of nitrogen tank refills every couple months that our older unit needed. Pictured below on the left is our upgraded dental unit and the pictured to the right is the units top storage area opened and set up with our other dental tools and supplies.





We also newly acquired a donated surgical table that has the ability to fold to create a v-trough which is useful during surgery/surgical prep to keep the animal positioned correctly on the table. The Picture to the left is it in the flat position and the picture to the right shows how it folds into a v-trough angle.





Adoption – Deb Klein Coordinator Manager, Kala Blasi and Mandi Durocher- Coordinators

We are getting ready for the spring/ summer adoptions.

After researching the surrounding Shelters and Humane Societies adoption fees we have adjusted or fees for cats from \$50 plus tax for most cats to \$55 plus tax for adults, \$75 plus tax for Kittens and \$30 plus tax for Seniors. We kept the second cat or kitten at no additional charge if going to the same household. Special needs cats/kittens fees will be adjusted.

Dog Adoption fees vary depending on age, breed, and size of the dog.

We have updated the information form on how to set up working cats in their new homes for their adjustment time. Mandi took new pictures of the sample enclosure and reworded some of the information in the hand out. This information goes with the working cats when adopted to help with the transition to a new outdoor home.

During the month of February three large dogs came to us as the owner could no longer care for them. One of the dogs, Lila Bean went to a wonderful family with two teens who will keep her busy. The bonded pair Simba and Kane went together to their new home. They now have a large fenced yard that they are allowed to come and go inside to outside! The larger dogs do usually have a longer stay here as most people are now looking for small apartment size dogs. We were very excited when a couple adopted the two bonded dogs!

We also sent two working dogs, Yuka and Big Time to the Crossroads Breed Rescue. Big Time was brought to our shelter as a stray 12/4/22. Yuka was brought in by our Humane Officers due to neglect. Both dogs will receive evaluation and training at the Crossroads Rescue. Then they will be placed in a proper home for their needs.

Animal Control - Brett Jarman Interim Leader

During March the Humane Officers have spent time developing:

- a check list of training opportunities
- a set of protocols
- a new poster and materials for reminding people that cars heat up quickly with poor results for any animals left inside
- an updated list of farm support services
- scenarios to use for radio communication training
- coloring book that will be used by Humane Officers at future events like June Dairy Days and Walk for Wags

As the temperature rose outside the number of animal bites increased. There were 11 bite cases in March and each of the Humane Officers had the opportunity to administer one or more of the cases,

During March we experienced an increase in calls to help with animals at risk after their owners had been evicted. While humane officers do not handle surrenders they do help the adoption team with a variety of services to help with the animal intake process.

One of our sad stories is when we received a call from a hospital nurse. One of her patients was worried about a cat when her overnight hospital stay became a several day stay. We obtained the owners consent to take the cat into protective custody. One owner returned home we drove the cat back to her. While we hoped this would be a happy ending to the story, later in the month owner attempted to leave the cat at HSPC's door. One of the Humane officers saw her on the video camera and went to the door before she drive off. The explanation was the cat was a stray and she didn't know what to do. During the intake process the officers involved with helping the owner earlier in the month recognized the cat. It was disheartening to have a person we had helped abandon her pet as a stray rather than do a surrender.

The county board has approved the extension of the animal control contract for 2023. We are expecting to receive payment early in April.

Humane Society of Portage County IT Status Report – March 2023

Many of the things I do and help with are like the movie Groundhog Day, we do them every month. Some we do every week and other are daily activities.

Board Support

Created the board package. (see May 2021 report for details).

Updated animal counts at the "Shelter Animal Count" web site

- Physical inventory of animals in the shelter. This process guarantees our computer systems match real life. It increases trust in the system
- Prepared the foster report.

ShelterBoss Software System

- Worked with software developer to fix problems on ShelterBoss. Updated several merge forms to better match our workflow.
- Helped the shelter in Rockwall Texas prepare of their conversion from Sheltertrack to shelterboss

IT Support

- Completed the agreement and down payment for the VoIP phone system.
- Continued discussions with a provider for support of the computer system. After discussions both
 parties concluded that what they were offering was not going to fit our budget. A new approach for
 computer support will be investigated.
- Investigations into the remaining steps to end our use of the analog phone lines was started.
 - The conversion of the fire alarm system to use cellular technology was started last December when HSPC experienced two false alarms. Alarm systems are sensitive to conversions from copper wire to digital. As phone companies replace copper wire with fiber the digital segments use compression software that human ears can not detect but computer systems on occasion may be confused. The solution is to upgrade the system to use a cellular connection.
 - o The FAX machine is the last device that uses an analog phone line. HSPC's use of FAX is quite small. Two groups that sent us the majority of faxes are the Hospitals sending bite reports and IDEX which sends us the results of veterinary tests we send them. IDEX recently stopped sending the results as FAX. The Aspirus Hospitals have also changed to sending reports as emails. We will convert to a software based FAX solution that will allow us to send emails to a FAX number and will receive FAX as an email sent to us. When the solution is place our FAX phone number will be ported to the software solution.

Facilities Update

An additional 12 fluorescent light bulbs have been converted to LED bulbs. I have been replacing bulbs
as the fluorescent bulbs expire. The LED bulbs cost a bit more but consume about one half of the
energy and last longer. The added benefits are the LED bulbs are plastic and do not contain any
mercury.







Volunteer Statistics

On February 5, 2023 there were (There were no volunteer staff count changes in March)

421 volunteers in the system

- -2 are in applicant status (volunteer applicants)
- -81 are in prospect status (job applicants)
- -42 staff members (34 are active)
- -296 Volunteers and fosters (includes staff who have fostered)

(21 with 10 or more hours in the past 180 days)

A purge of inactive staff occurred on January 2nd, 2023

A purge of inactive volunteers was performed on March 6, 2021. This purge was volunteers with zero hours of service, volunteer applicants, and staff that have left our employment. The normal criteria for purging is no recent service in past 100 days or applicant for more than 100 days is the criteria for purging.

The pandemic has dramatically reduced our use of volunteers. We expect a different more structured volunteer program to be implemented in the last quarter of 2021.

HSPC staff are in Volgistics. Staff and medical provider hours are excluded from the volunteer reports

Fosters were reconciled in December 2020 which reduced the number of active fosters.


DonorPerfect Statistics

DonorPerfect is software that helps HSPC record information about our donors and patrons. It has been active since the end of August 2013


- All Individual monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All Business and organization monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All contributions are put into DonorPerfect (cash and non-cash gifts)
- All Volunteers are added to DonorPerfect (updated every 4 months)
- Any person that attends one of our major events and purchases an item (registration, auction) are added to Donor Perfect
- All people who make in-kind donations and sign our gift registry have been loaded into Donor

 Perfect
- All mailing lists have been consolidated into Donor Perfect
- All people who have adopted a pet from HSPC in the past 5 years have been loaded into Donor Perfect. New adopters are added each week.
- Donor Perfect has been the system of record for all donations since August 2013.

Our donor base continues to grow. In January 2014 we had 6,289 donors and in January 2015 we had 7,655. On April 1, 2023 we have 16,355 constituent records in our Donor Perfect database. Note: 4,679 are do not mail records.





Note: Large estate gifts received in February 2021, April 2021 and December 2022 will skew many of these graphs.



NOTE: In January 2023 we discovered that items that contained a memorial or honorarium message had been coded as memorial or honorarium income. This would cause some of the solicitation reports to have shown lower results than actual. All the gifts were counted it was only the coding of general ledger codes that was incorrect. Our goal is to use the general ledger code for the source of the gift.

In October 2020 Donor Perfect added an additional dashboard item that shows monthly donors.







The following reports from DonorPerfect will provide additional details.

In September 2021 the Humane Officer team was restructured. A new interim manger was appointed and the interim manager attended the Humane Officer training program conducted by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) in Madison. This week long course is required training for all Humane Officers.

Based on the training in the class many of the ways the HSPC Humane Officers were using our computer system were reviewed and analyzed for efficiency and accuracy. Several changes were implemented that will cause the following report to look different in 2022. One of these changes is the way we track animals that are received as stray or surrendered animals.

HSPC receives nearly 1,000 stray or surrendered animals each year. The majority of the animals are brought to the shelter. In 2021 the animals was entered into the computer system and an additional / duplicate entry was made as a dispatch. The dispatch entries would show up on the report shown below. In late 2021 we stopped creating dispatches for stray and surrendered animals that were not part of an investigation.

It is our hope that we can change the way the report is produced to reflect both the dispatch counts and the animal intake counts.

In January 2023 the format of the Humane Officer report was changed so it was easier to read. This new version does not include the animal intake counts.
