Euthanasia numbers: none

- This month we had fewer surgeries than normal due to one of our Veterinarians was gone for most of the month of April.
- We are beginning to see pregnant cats and cats with newborns arriving at the shelter which indicates we have started into "kitten season".
- We have one ringworm positive cat currently at the shelter that is being treated. Treatment can range from a few weeks to months depending on how quickly he responds to treatment. During treatment they are kept isolated from the rest of the population as ringworm can be spread. Oral medication and topical treatment are used along with doing weekly cultures and woods lamping to verify if still positive or if they have cleared it. Once they clear they are able to rejoin the shelter population and become adoptable.

Shelter Care - Mandi Durocher Shelter Care Manager

April was an exciting month for Shelter Care!

We finally cleared the Giardia in the building and were able to resume normal protocols...for two days before one of our stray intakes tested positive. We are resuming Giardia protocol but on a different scale. The dog that tested positive for Giardia is a part of a group of 3 dogs who were found together. These dogs were not at all familiar with leashes or collars when they came in and were terrified of us. Thankfully, we have Samantha (Sammy) Williams on board as our small dog whisperer! Sammy is the only one of my staff of fourteen that has been able to walk them. Because of this, we are doing protocol a little different. We are following the protocol for only the 3 dogs that came in together, and are able to do the other dogs as normal. This has been the closest thing dog staff has gotten to a break since winter!

Our dog counts have been widely fluctuating and to reflect that our Team 2 Dog Helper shift also changes with our numbers. It can be either 7am-10am, 7am-11am, or 7am-12pm. With summer coming up and more cats coming in, I may have to increase our Team 1 Cat Helper shift from 7am-12pm to 7am-1pm- but it hasn't needed to happen yet.

April has shown us signs of what is to come in summer, all I can say is bring it on- Shelter Care is ready!

Adoption – Deb Klein Coordinator Manager, Kala Blasi and Mandi Durocher- Coordinators

We had received an extraordinary amount of surrender requests during the month of April. And the requests continue on into May. The reasons given for surrender over the years have mostly been moving, allergies, puppy to much work, landlord and family situations. Numerus surrender requests we have received recently are for aggressive dogs or dogs that have no training and are out of control. People say they are finding some of these dogs on Facebook and Craig List posts and also Rescues that work with out of State shelters. The new owners of these dogs call or email our office sometimes just a day or two after they pick up their new dog wanting to surrender it to us. I have been told many times the dog is to aggressive to have in their home and the person/rescue they adopted the dog from refuse to take it back. It is very sad and sometimes dangerous situation for the people who believe they are saving the life of a homeless dog but are not told the truth about the dog's behavior or temperament, and are not prepared. Our office also continues to receive many requests for surrenders from people outside of our service area.

It is that time of year that we now have many Mom's with kittens and pregnant cats in coming in. We have been able to get most into foster care. We are very Thank full to our foster families who take the kitties into their homes to socialize and care for them.

Bonded pairs usually have to wait a little longer to find a home but these two didn't have to wait very long. Animal Control - Brett Jarman Interim Leader

With warmer weather there are more hours spent outdoors and we experience an increase in animal activities. April had a sharp increase in the number of bite reports we handled. April had 15 reported animal bites which is twice as many as March. There were 20 Animal mistreatment reports in April triple the number March had.

Many of our dispatches have become more complex. Twice this month owners of animals have attempted and succeeded in turning their owned pet in as a stray animal. After investigation we work to have them surrender the animal and if unsuccessful they are cited for abandonment.

One of our welfare checks found puppies living in a camping trailer. The trailer owners were both being held in custody. Fortunately one was released and wanted to care for the puppies.

On April 7, 2023 HSPC received a call from a property owner that someone had dumped a dog out on his property. They rented the large dog trap from us on April 8 to try to catch the dog. The dog was very scared during this time on George's property and would not come to them. They set the trap up in their backyard and on April 23 the dog entered the trap and was contained! They immediately called us and we went to pick him up that night. When vet staff looked him over, he was covered in ticks, but with patience he allowed staff to remove the ticks that were not dying off with the flea and tick treatment we provided him. The dog which we named Linc, is such a sweet loving boy and is in the process of being adopted.







Volunteer Statistics

On May 6, 2023 a purge of inactive volunteers was performed. This is the first volunteer purge since 2019. During the pandemic years we were unsure what impact would be on the volunteers. Many of our volunteers are students. Most students graduate in four years so this purge had a significant impact. A reconciliation of active fosters will be done at a later date.

Over the past few months we have stopped using Volgistics to schedule staff. There were several volunteer entries we established to support scheduling. WE also had broken many of the jobs down into smaller pieces to support scheduling. All of these items have been marked as inactive. The result of these changes provides the ability to report staff hours along with volunteer hours. This new report started in May 2023 and replaces the previous report which only covered volunteers.

198 people entries in the system

- -8 inactive
- -32 applicants (volunteer applicants received in 2023)
- -24 prospects (job applicants)
- -34 staff (30 worked hours in April)
- -134 volunteers (32 have volunteer hours in 2023
 - 25 performed fostering
 - 9 performed volunteer services some did both)


A purge of inactive staff occurred on January 2nd, 2023

A purge of inactive volunteers was performed on May 6, 2023. This purge was volunteers with zero hours of service, volunteer applicants, and staff that have left our employment. The normal criteria for purging is no recent service in past 100 days or applicant for more than 100 days is the criteria for purging.

The pandemic has dramatically reduced our use of volunteers. We expect a different more structured volunteer program to be implemented in the last quarter of 2021.

Fosters were reconciled in December 2020 which reduced the number of active fosters.


DonorPerfect Statistics

DonorPerfect is software that helps HSPC record information about our donors and patrons. It has been active since the end of August 2013


- All Individual monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All Business and organization monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All contributions are put into DonorPerfect (cash and non-cash gifts)
- All Volunteers are added to DonorPerfect (updated every 4 months)
- Any person that attends one of our major events and purchases an item (registration, auction) are added to Donor Perfect
- All people who make in-kind donations and sign our gift registry have been loaded into Donor

 Perfect
- All mailing lists have been consolidated into Donor Perfect
- All people who have adopted a pet from HSPC in the past 5 years have been loaded into Donor Perfect. New adopters are added each week.
- Donor Perfect has been the system of record for all donations since August 2013.

Our donor base continues to grow. In January 2014 we had 6,289 donors and in January 2015 we had 7,655. On May 4, 2023 we have 16,390 constituent records in our Donor Perfect database. Note: 4,685 are do not mail records.





Note: Large estate gifts received in February 2021, April 2021 and December 2022 will skew many of these graphs.



NOTE: In January 2023 we discovered that items that contained a memorial or honorarium message had been coded as memorial or honorarium income. This would cause some of the solicitation reports to have shown lower results than actual. All the gifts were counted it was only the coding of general ledger codes that was incorrect. Our goal is to use the general ledger code for the source of the gift.

In October 2020 Donor Perfect added an additional dashboard item that shows monthly donors.

In September 2021 the Humane Officer team was restructured. A new interim manger was appointed and the interim manager attended the Humane Officer training program conducted by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) in Madison. This week long course is required training for all Humane Officers.

Based on the training in the class many of the ways the HSPC Humane Officers were using our computer system were reviewed and analyzed for efficiency and accuracy. Several changes were implemented that will cause the following report to look different in 2022. One of these changes is the way we track animals that are received as stray or surrendered animals.

HSPC receives nearly 1,000 stray or surrendered animals each year. The majority of the animals are brought to the shelter. In 2021 the animals was entered into the computer system and an additional / duplicate entry was made as a dispatch. The dispatch entries would show up on the report shown below. In late 2021 we stopped creating dispatches for stray and surrendered animals that were not part of an investigation.

It is our hope that we can change the way the report is produced to reflect both the dispatch counts and the animal intake counts.

In January 2023 the format of the Humane Officer report was changed so it was easier to read. This new version does not include the animal intake counts.
