Medical updates this month:

- Got in a transfer dog from Copper Paws Rescue-confirmed parvo positive. Being treated currently.
- 2 litter mate puppies came in- coccidia positive.
- Dr Mel Beyer has been doing surgery a few days a month and she has been working out great.
- We will be getting 2 UWSP pre-vet students shadowing/volunteering in the med department over the summer.
- First confirmed ringworm cat was sent to the Fit Center in Madison for treatment.

Animal Control – Victoria Nellessen – Animal Control Manager

In the beginning of May we had two animals come in through suspicious circumstances and potential abandonment. During our attempts to achieve surrender the owners decided to continue to care for the animals. We have since been in touch with both owners and have verified that the animals are in good condition and have safe housing. We also had a dog come in that was known to be owned by a questionable individual with multiple welfare complaints about his animals including the one that was found on the road. The owner payed the full reclaim fee and all medical fees and retrieve his dog.

We investigated a potential poisoning of working cats and worked with med team to ascertain that poisoning was not the cause of death for the cats.

We reinvestigated a farm that we visited last summer who had puppies that were being sold out of a trailer. There was a complaint about it being a puppy mill last summer. This year it was a complaint of a abuse situation. Last year we concluded no foul play, but a farmer who had 3 farm dogs that were unfixed. This year he admitted to breeding his dogs and selling the puppies but the conditions of all the dogs were legal and again no foul play was seen.

There were 2 hot car calls that required a response and report. 5 Dogs were brought in as protective custody and were eventually reclaimed. There were 3 welfare concerns regarding horses and donkeys. The horses and donkeys have ongoing investigations.

There were 2 dogs confirmed abandoned in May. One of them, Era, was able to be contained by ACOs and brought into the Humane Society of Portage County. The other dog, Duke, who had previously been deemed vicious, continues to run at large.

As always, there were multiple running at large concerns, bite reports, and barking complaints.

Adoption – Deb Klein Adoption Coordinator for dogs & Tammy Mathewson - Adoption Volunteer Assistant

During the month of May six dogs were matched to their forever homes. Three of the dogs were medium-large size, three were puppies to be medium sized adults. One dog, Max a busy high energy Border Collie was taken in by a private Border Collie Rescue that will train Max and find him a best matched home when he is ready. A picture of the adopted dogs and Max included.

Phone surrender requests for the month of May totaled 44. Out of the 44 we had 19 **dog** surrender requests. 11 were from people living out of Portage County. There were 8 **dog** surrender requests from people living in Portage County.

We received 7 **cat** surrender requests from people living out of our area and 11 **cat** surrender requests from people living in Portage County.

One rabbit surrender request from someone in our county.

These surrender requests numbers do not include email requests or requests from people who just stop by our shelter to surrender a pet. There are also people who have multiple cats that live on their property they no longer want. These cats are usually live trapped with the help of our Humane Officers.

Volunteer Statistics

On May 6, 2023 a purge of inactive volunteers was performed. This is the first volunteer purge since 2019. During the pandemic years we were unsure what impact would be on the volunteers. Many of our volunteers are students. Most students graduate in four years so this purge had a significant impact. A reconciliation of active fosters will be done at a later date.

Over the past few months we have stopped using Volgistics to schedule staff. There were several volunteer entries we established to support scheduling. WE also had broken many of the jobs down into smaller pieces to support scheduling. All of these items have been marked as inactive. The result of these changes provides the ability to report staff hours along with volunteer hours. This new report started in May 2023 and replaces the previous report which only covered volunteers.

There are many volunteers that help us with events and several board members helping with community activities and veterinary services that are not counted in these reports.

A purge of inactive staff occurred on January 2nd, 2023

A purge of inactive volunteers was performed on May 6, 2023. This purge was volunteers with zero hours of service, volunteer applicants, and staff that have left our employment. The normal criteria for purging is no recent service in past 100 days or applicant for more than 100 days is the criteria for purging.

The pandemic has dramatically reduced our use of volunteers. We expect a different more structured volunteer program to be implemented in the last quarter of 2021.

Fosters were reconciled in December 2020 which reduced the number of active fosters.

In August 2024 several purges from Volgistics were performed.

Foster counts will resume in the October board package.

A purge of prospective employment applications was done on November 15, 2024

On November 15 there were 205 volunteer and 55 job applicants in the system. There were 144 volunteers (76 have never had any activity, 29 had no activity in Octobers and 39 performed volunteer service or fostered animals)

On April 12, 2025 two purges were performed, 179 applicants and 6 control names were archived. The 179 applicants had been applicants for more than six months.

Currently there are 89 applicants. 44 job prospects, 39 staff (8 inactive staff), and 161 fosters / volunteers (50 have performed service in 2025 – 111 no service in 2025 include fosters or event staff).

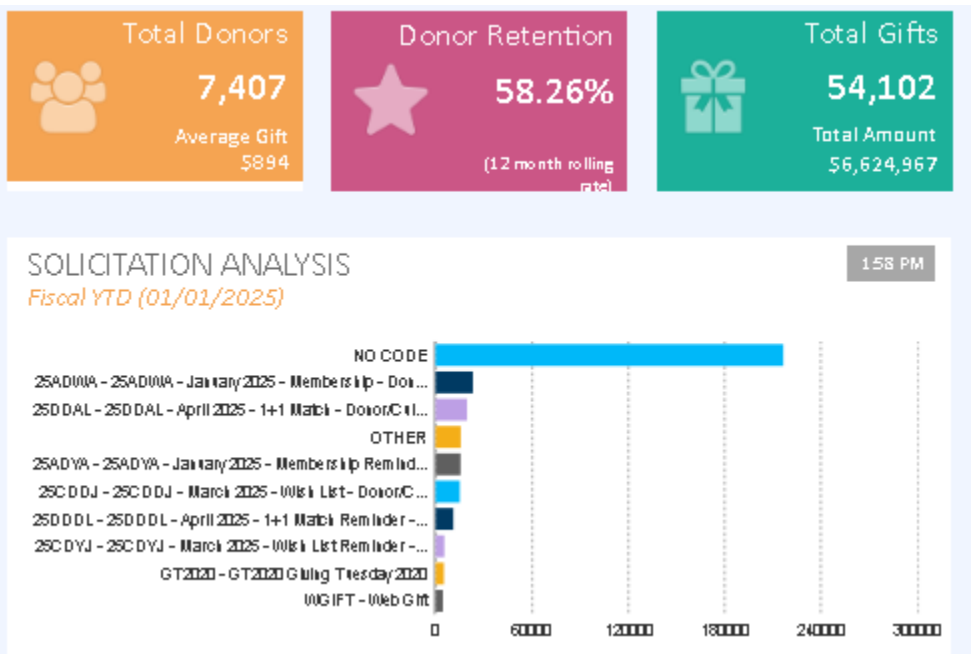

DonorPerfect Statistics

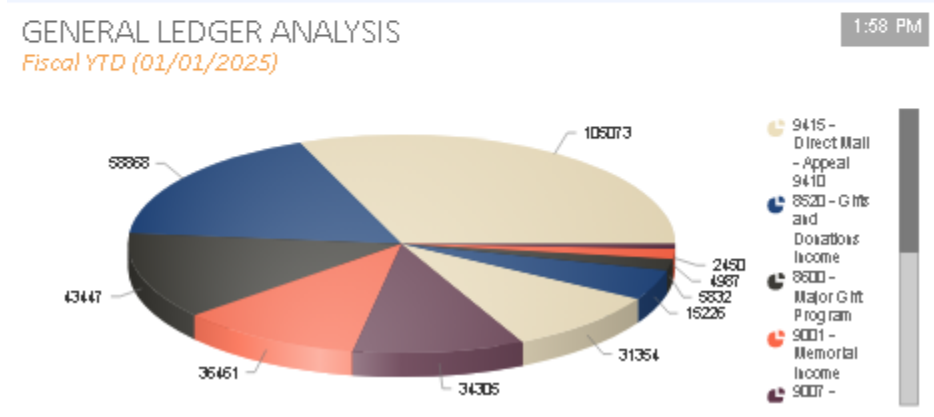
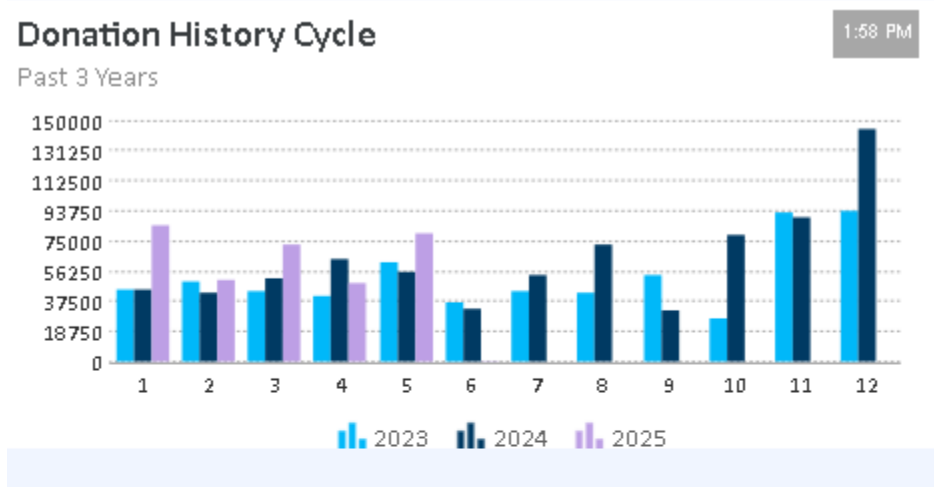
DonorPerfect is software that helps HSPC record information about our donors and patrons. It has been active since the end of August 2013

- All Individual monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All Business and organization monetary donations has been extracted from our old system and loaded.
- All contributions are put into DonorPerfect (cash and non-cash gifts)
- All Volunteers are added to DonorPerfect – (updated every 4 months)
- Any person that attends one of our major events and purchases an item (registration , auction) are added to Donor Perfect
- All people who make in-kind donations and sign our gift registry have been loaded into Donor Perfect.
- All mailing lists have been consolidated into Donor Perfect
- All people who have adopted a pet from HSPC in the past 5 years have been loaded into Donor Perfect. New adopters are added each week.
- Donor Perfect has been the system of record for all donations since August 2013.

Our donor base continues to grow. In January 2014 we had 6,289 donors and in January 2015 we had 7,655. On January 1, 2025 we have 12,051 constituent records in our Donor Perfect database. Note: 4,846 are do not mail records. In December 2024 we removed 5,686 donor records that were marked as no-mail and had never given a gift. Also removed 609 donor records that were marked as no mail and the value of all of their gifts = zero dollars. Also removed 2,996 no mail donors with last gift 2017 or earlier On June 1, 2025 we had 8.626 donors.



Note: Large estate gifts received in February 2021, April 2021 & December 2022 will skew these graphs.

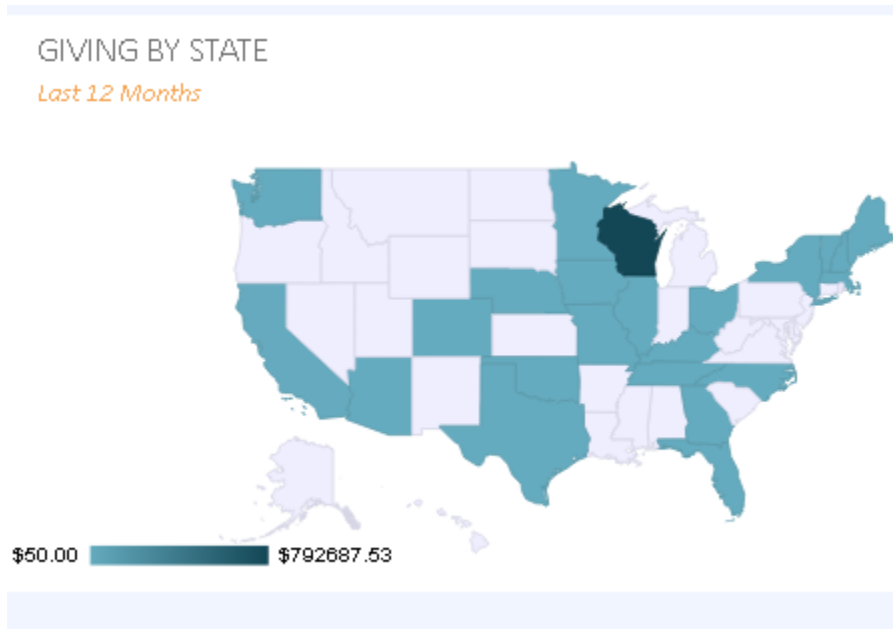
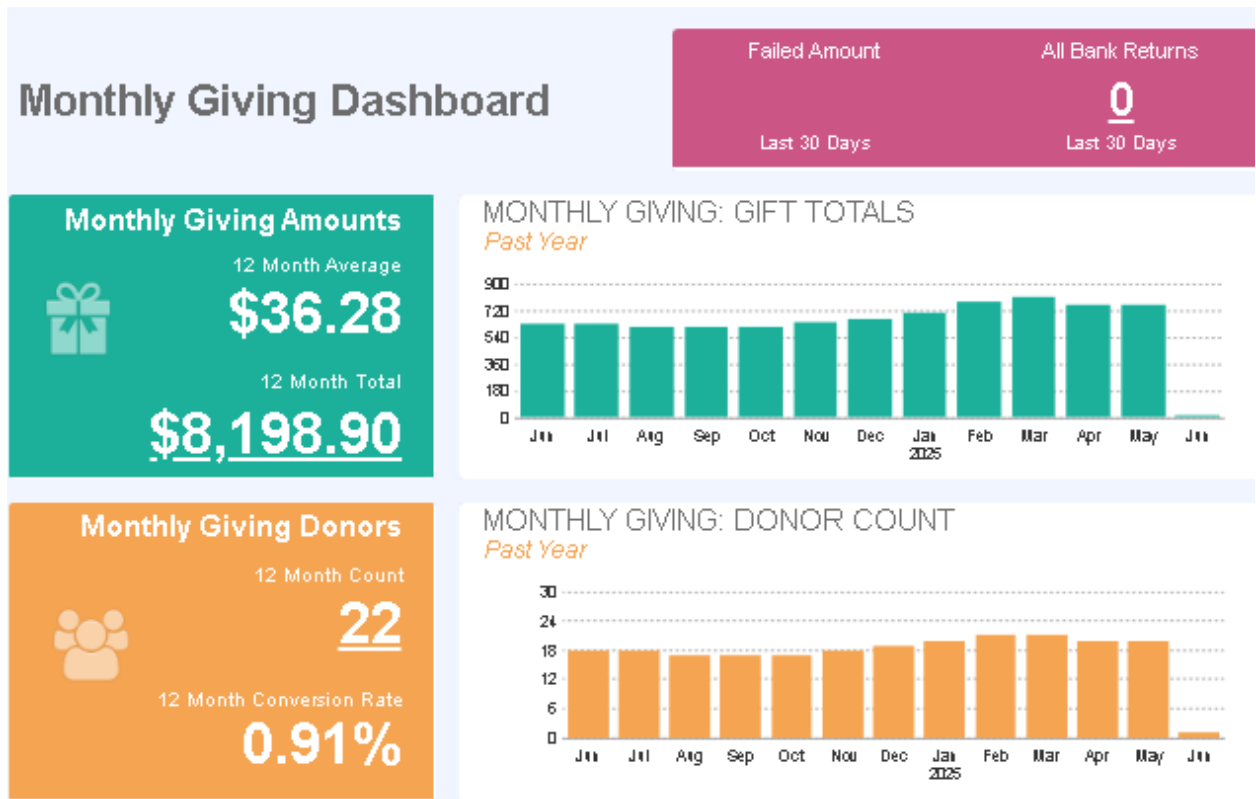


NOTE: In January 2023 we discovered that items that contained a memorial or honorarium message had been coded as memorial or honorarium income. This would cause some of the solicitation reports to have shown lower results than actual. All the gifts were counted it was only the coding of general ledger codes that was incorrect. Our goal is to use the general ledger code for the source of the gift.

NOTE: In May 2023 we analyzed the names in our donor database. As part of the analysis we performed a calculated process to remove people from our active mailing database. Examples of our criteria include:

- Names with incomplete addresses
- Potential donors that have been receiving mail from us for 3 or more years and never made a gift
- Donors that have made a gift in the past but have not made any gifts for the past 4 years
- Donors that live outside of our service area (Portage County) and have not made any gifts in the past 2 years.
- Donors that have made only one gift and the gift was made in memory or in honor of a person or animal and this single gift was made more than a year ago.

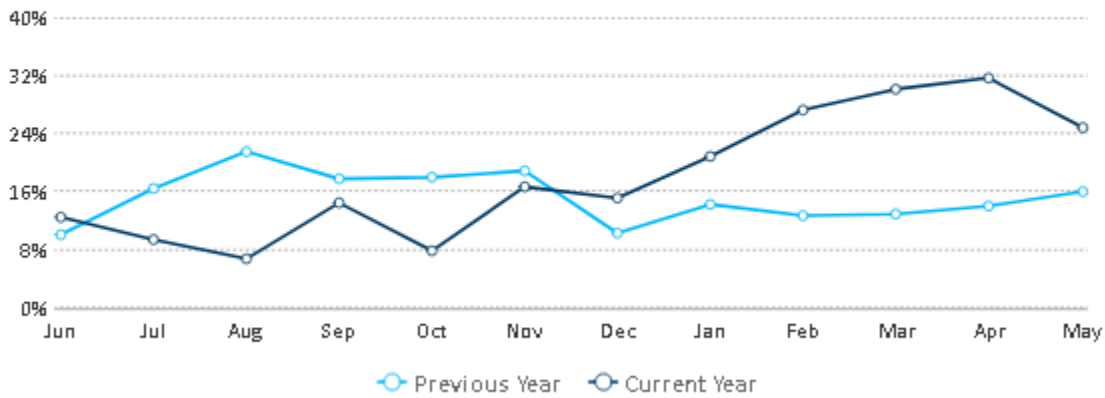
In October 2020 Donor Perfect added an additional dashboard item that shows monthly donors.

2:00 PM

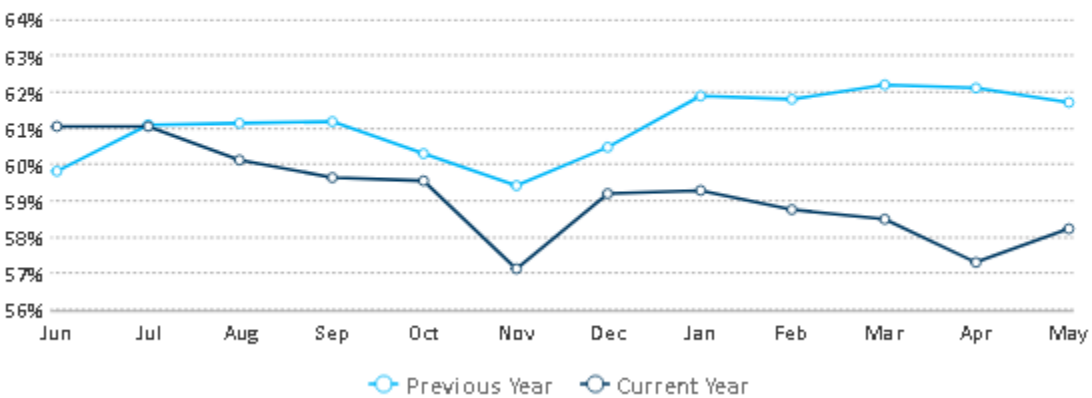
Last 24 Months

In September 2021 the Humane Officer team was restructured. A new interim manger was appointed and the interim manager attended the Humane Officer training program conducted by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) in Madison. This week long course is required training for all Humane Officers.

Based on the training in the class many of the ways the HSPC Humane Officers were using our computer system were reviewed and analyzed for efficiency and accuracy. Several changes were implemented that will cause the following report to look different in 2022. One of these changes is the way we track animals that are received as stray or surrendered animals.

HSPC receives nearly 1,000 stray or surrendered animals each year. The majority of the animals are brought to the shelter. In 2021 the animals was entered into the computer system and an additional / duplicate entry was made as a dispatch. The dispatch entries would show up on the report shown below. In late 2021 we stopped creating dispatches for stray and surrendered animals that were not part of an investigation.

It is our hope that we can change the way the report is produced to reflect both the dispatch counts and the animal intake counts.

In January 2023 the format of the Humane Officer report was changed so it was easier to read. This new version does not include the animal intake counts.

In June 2025 the animal control report format has changed slightly. A manual Excel spreadsheet has been replaced with the report generated by sheltertrack. The information is the same but the formatting is different.

In these situations euthanasia may be our only recourse if an animal has dangerous behavior or temperament that can't be corrected, a fatal or chronic disease, or is seriously injured.
